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### PROCESS FOR IDENTIFYING WEAK AND BRIGHT STUDENTS

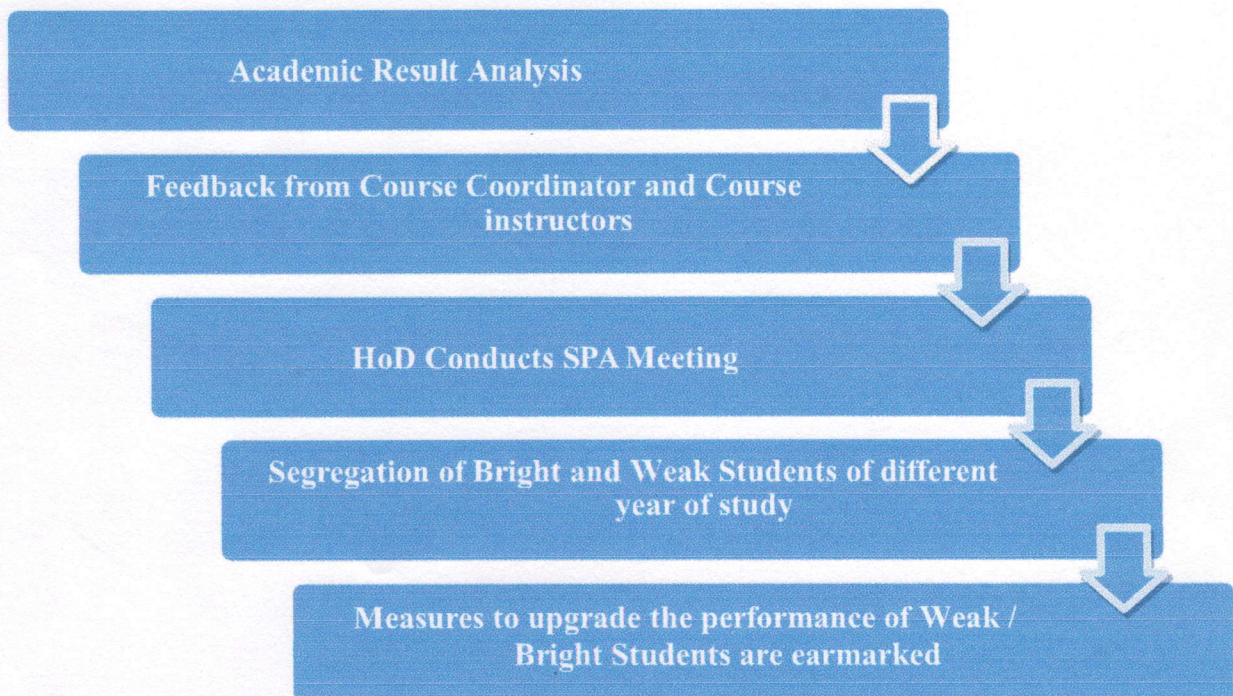


Figure 2.2.1.a: Process to identify weak and bright students

The faculties under the chairmanship of the Head of the department meet after the Semester End Examination results to identify the bright and weak students as well as to discuss the probable measures in enhancing the overall performance of the students. The methodology adopted for the same is depicted in Figure 2.2.1.a

#### ➤ Support to weak students

- Weak students are identified by considering 10 lowest marks scored students in the university examinations. Also, their orientation towards academics, feedback from course coordinators are considered for identification of weak students.
- Weak students are **counselled and motivated** by their respective mentors/HOD.
- Remedial classes** for theory courses are conducted before the SEE.
- Parents are informed about the performance of the students during the **Parents-Teachers Meeting** and personal mentoring and counselling is extended intensively by respective faculty members.

➤ **Encouragement to bright students**

- a. Bright students are identified by considering top 10 students based on the results of previous university examinations and the same list of students are circulated among the course co ordinators to identify 5 bright students among them.
- b. Encouraged to **participate** in conferences, workshops, and technical and non technical competitions.
- c. Encouraged to be the **editorial members** for brochures, newsletters and magazines of the department and college.
- d. The student topper in each year is honored by the institution with **cash prize** to encourage the bright students.
- e. The names and photos of bright students are **displayed on the notice board** and **Newsletters/Magazines** of the department.
- f. **Appreciation certificate** is given to the students who have exhibited their knowledge and skills in both technical and Non technical aspect.
- g. Bright students having high academic track records are **encouraged to achieve university ranks and take up competitive exams** like GRE,GATE etc.

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
